COMPLETING SENTENCE

RULES:

(xi) As/since/when:

Structure: As/since/when + sub + verb(past/present) + obj + ext + , + sub + verb(present/past) + obj + ext.

Example: (a) As he is weak in math, he goes to tutor.

- (b) Since you were not ready for the exam, you would not pass in the exam.
- (c) When you will come to our house, I will give you the book.

(xii) In spite of/despite:

Structure: Sub + verb + obj + ext + in spite of/despite + (possessive + noun)/noun/(possessive + verb + ing + noun).

Example: (a) He is honest in spite of his poverty.

(xiii) Instead of / In lue of :

Structure: Instead of / in lue of + noun + sub + verb + obj.

Example: (a) He ate fish instead of meat. (b) Instead of pencil he took pen.

(xiv) Lest:

Structure: Sub + verb(present/past) + obj + ext + lest + sub + should/might + verb(present) + obj + ext.

Example: (a) Read attentively lest you should fail in the exam. (b) He walked past lest he should not see me.

(xv) Let alone:

Structure: Sub + verb + obj(v/n) + let alone + v/n.

Example: (a) He can not get daily food let alone rich food. (b) He can not read let alone write. (xvi) Relative pronoun (who, which, that):
Structure: 1. Sub + verb + obj + ext + relative pronoun + verb + obj + ext.
2. Sub + relative pronoun + verb + obj + ext + verb + obj + ext.

Example: (a) I know the man who is a doctor. (b) The pen which is given by my friend writes well.

(xvii) High time / It is the time:

Structure: 1. It is the time/high time + sub + verb(past) + obj + ext. 2. It is the time/high time + to + verb(present) + ext.

Example: (a) It is the time/high time we left the place. (b) It is the time/high time to leave the place.

(xviii) Because of / on account of / owing to / due to:

Structure: Because of / on account of / owing to / due to + cause + result. Cause = (verb + ing) / noun / (possessive + verb + ing /noun) Result = Sub + verb + obj + ext.

Example: (a) He could not attend the meeting because of his illness.

(xix) Would you mind:

Structure: Would you mind + verb + ing + obj + ext.

Example: (a) Would you mind giving me the pen.

(xx) Would rather:

Structure: Would rather + sub + verb(present) + obj + ext + than + verb.

Example: (a) Would rather I take tea than coffe.

(xxi) As long as / So far as:

Structure: As long as / So far as + sub + verb + obj + ext + , + sub + verb + obj + ext.

Example: (a) So far as I know he is a good boy.

(xxii) Would that / Wish:

Structure: 1.Practical \rightarrow Sub + verb(future ind) + obj + ext. 2. Impractical \rightarrow Sub + verb(past ind) + obj + ext.

Example: (a) I wish I will make a good result. (b) I wish I would fly in the sky.
