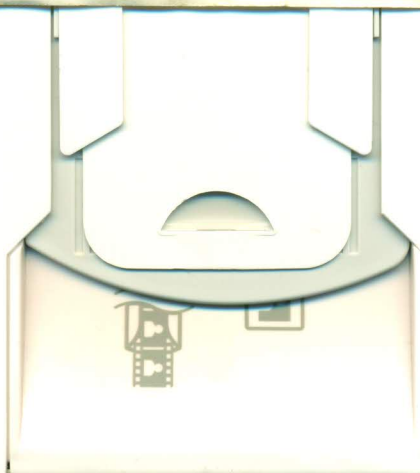

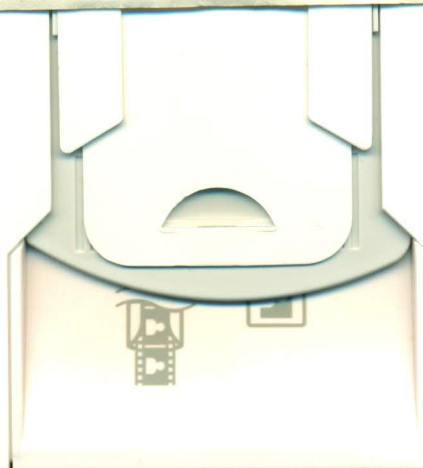

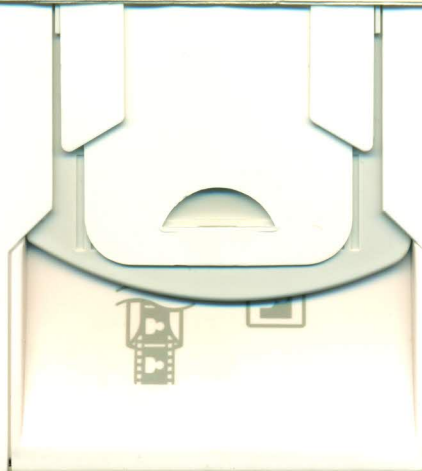

Critics claim that Facebook isolates people from one another by putting users behind a computer screen. Accordingly, fluctuations over periods shorter than a few decades do not represent climate change. The term sometimes is used to refer specifically to climate change caused by human activity, as opposed to changes in climate that may have resulted as part of earth's natural processes.

Recently the scientists have reported that world's climate is undergoing a significant change. It is evident that world temperatures are increasing day by day. This increase in global warming is caused by increasing amount of carbon dioxide. Greenhouse effect is the likely cause of global warming. The earth's climate is changing. Its temperature has increased by about 0.7° C since the industrial revolution. These climate changes are caused primarily by the emission of greenhouse gases from the burning of fossil fuels and secondarily from changes in land use caused by agriculture and forestry.

There are many causes of climate change. This is caused by destruction of trees, smoke of motor vehicles, rapid growth of industry, use of CFCs and use of detergents. United Nations secretary general Ban Ki-Moon says, "Climate change already under way is more frightening than any science fiction movie". There is a 90% chance that climate change is caused by human activity and may bring abrupt effects. The scientists predict that midway through the next century, temperatures may have risen by as much as 4°C. This can reduce mankind's ability to grow food, destroy or damage wildlife, raise sea level and thereby flood coastal areas and farmland. The alarming news about Bangladesh is that as a result of the rise of the sea level, the lower southern part of the country may one day go under water.
