

## Some Important Structures of Sentence

### 1. Subject + Verb+ Object

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Verb</b>	<b>Object</b>
They	play	football
Mita	watches	television

### 2. Subject + Transitive Verb+ Object + Extension (Adverbial)

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Transitive Verb</b>	<b>Object</b>	<b>Extension (Adverbial)</b>
He	bought	a pen	from new market
Shima	noted	it	down

### 3. Subject + Intransitive Verb+ Extension (Adverbial)

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Transitive Verb</b>	<b>Extension (Adverbial)</b>
Lima	sleeps	on the floor
He	went	to the hospital

### 4. Subject + Transitive Verb+ Object + Participle/Gerund/Infinitive

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Verb</b>	<b>Object</b>	<b>Participle/Gerund/Infinitive</b>
I	found	her	reading
Mother	hates	me	coming late for dinner
Parents	wish	children	to rise high in life

### 5. Subject + Transitive Verb+ Object + Bare Infinitive

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Verb</b>	<b>Object</b>	<b>Bare Infinitive</b>
She	made	me	Laugh
Rahim	helped	them	set up the fire

### 6. Subject + Transitive Verb+ Object+ Object Complement

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Verb</b>	<b>Object</b>	<b>Complement</b>
We	made	him	captain
They	nominated	me	the monitor

7. Subject + Linking Verb+ Complement (Noun/Adjective)

Subject	Linking Verb	Complement (Noun/Adjective)
She	becomes	a nurse
Rahim	got	angry

8. Subject + Quasi Passive Verb+ Complement

Subject	Quasi Passive Verb	Complement
Honey	tastes	sweet
The bed	feels	soft

9. If + Present+ Future

If	Present	Future
If	you go there	you will find her
If	they watch television	you will get pleasure

10. If + Past+ Future in the past

If	Past	Future in the past
If	you went there	you would find her
If	they watched television	you would get pleasure

11. If + Past perfect+ Future in the past perfect+

If	Past Perfect	Future in the Past Perfect
If	you had gone there	you would have found her
If	they had watched television	you would have got pleasure

12. By/Without+ Gerund+ Complement+ Another clause

By/Without	Gerund	Complement	Another clause
By	doing	the work	you will have the opportunity
without	taking	regular exercise	he cannot remain hale and hearty

13. Interrogative Adverb+ Auxiliary Verb+ Subject+ Principal Verb+ Object+?

Interrogative Adverb	Auxiliary Verb	Subject	Principal Verb	Object+?
Why	do	you	help	her?
How	did	he	do	the work?
