

Definition of verbs: The verbs are those words which denotes being, having and doing something.

Task: The word or phrase that gives the action or asserts something, in a sentence, clause etc.

Forms of verb: It is classified in five forms are given below:

Base form
 S or es form
 Ing form
 Past form
 Past participle form

#01.Base form: In the present and future indefinite tense, after model auxiliary, let, help, to, cannot but, had better, had rather, would better, would rather etc. the verb will be in base form.

Modal Auxiliaries: will, would, shall, should, can, could, may, might, must, need, dare, have to, has to, had to, ought to etc.

For example:

- I will go to Canada for my better treatment.
- \blacksquare Let me finish the topic.
- I can do it.

#02.S or es form: In present indefinite if the subject is 3^{rd} person singular number, the verb will be in s or es form.

For example:

- ■*She reads newspaper daily.*
- The student works hard to make a good result.

#03.Ing form: In continues tense, after preposition, mind, would you mind, cannot help, with a view to, look forward to, habituated to, get used to, addicted to, contributed to, prefer to etc. the verb will be in 'ing' form.

For example:

- I do not mind discussing the matter.
- We are looking forward to meeting you.
- *I* went to the library with a view to reading there.

#04.Past form: In past indefinite tense, after since, long since, before, ago, once upon a time, high time, it is the time, fancy, wish, yesterday, the previous day \mathcal{L} last the verb will be in past form.

For example:

It was long since we met in Dhaka.
Once upon a time there lived a king called Midas.
He went home yesterday.

#05.Past participle form: In perfect tense *I* passive voice after (model auxiliary + be), to be, having, being, linking verb etc. the verb will be in past participle form.

Linking Verbs: become, get, grow, turn, feel, look, smell, seem, hear, touch, taste etc.

For example:

- *The injured person should be removed from the source of hate.*
- Your parents ought to be obeyed by you.
- ■*Having rested a while we began our journey*
